



## CODES OF CONDUCT

### RESPECT HOUSE OF ALLAH, YOURSELF AND OTHERS

#### Actions Prohibited at Central Scotland Islamic Centre

- Entry in mosque when building is closed
- Unauthorized public meetings and gatherings in or on mosque premises
- Disturbing activities ,events or services
- Disturbing the peace
- Physical or verbal abuse of others
- Inciting disruptive riotous behaviour in or on premises
- Intimidating, threatening, harassing, criminal acts and/or behaviours
- Illegal parking
- Entry in mosque when in possession or under the influence of alcohol / illegal drugs
- Carrying illegal firearms
- Smoking
- Buying and selling
- Male / Female interaction (allowed only under Islamic principles not necessary by cultural reasoning).
- Terrorism and racism.
- Any sort of interference in administration by worshipers.

#### Activites Requiring Administration Approval Before Doing

- Performing Islamic counselling, Marriage, Divorce, Family services etc..
- Soliciting, collecting money, posting and / or passing out flyers in/on mosque premises
- Making announcements or public statements (using microphone or not)
- Educational, social activities and / or functions (bringing /serving food inviting guest lecturers holding public gatherings or meetings, Islamic teaching or classes of any kind, inviting groups for mosque visits sleeping and staying in mosque)

#### Mosque Services All requests must be submitted in writing.

- Request for marriage services require prior notice and proper documents in accordance to law.
- Grievances, funerals, concerns, questions, other services must be written and should include complete contact information and details
